- Ability to communicate effectively (oral/written) to a variety of audiences and switch fluently between languages.
- Disciplined and methodical approach to work, paying close attention to detail and with a focus on quality
- Ability to accurately organize translated materials and finalize translation according to prescribed standards including order, clarity, conciseness, style, and terminology
- Strong planning, organizational, multi-tasking, and time-management skills
