Translators are professional communicators who translate written documents from one language to another.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

You are eligible to apply in translation if you meet any of the following criteria:

1. Hold a Canadian bachelor's degree, master's degree, or doctorate in translation.

OR

2. Hold a foreign bachelor's degree, master's degree, or doctorate in translation.

OR

Hold a bachelor's degree, a master's degree, or a doctorate in any domain, awarded by a Canadian or foreign
institution plus two years of full-time* translation experience in the language combination for which you are
applying.

OR

- 4. Have the equivalent of four years of **full-time*** translation experience in the language combination for which you are applying.
 - Foreign academic credentials must be evaluated by World Education Services (www.wes.org/ca/) or the International Credential Assessment Service of Canada (http://www.icascanada.ca/).
 - Full Time Experience is considered more than 100,000 words translated per year or at least 30 hours of translation work per week.
 - Your translation experience must be from within the last five years and must be attested to by a recent letter
 of reference from an employer or from two or more clients (each providing a letter) if you work as an
 independent/freelance translator.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS Any documents not already in English or French must be translated by an ATIO Certified Translator. All applications must include the following: Signed and completed application form. Your curriculum vitae. A copy of a valid photo ID issued by a Canadian institution. (CHOOSE ONE) Submit the following supporting documents according to the criteria under which you are applying:

- 1. Hold a Canadian bachelor's degree, master's degree, or doctorate in translation.
 - A copy of your Canadian degree in translation.
 - A copy of your transcripts indicating completed courses in translation.
- 2. Hold a foreign bachelor's degree, master's degree, or doctorate in translation.
 - A copy of your foreign degree in translation.
 - A copy of your transcripts indicating completed courses in translation.
 - A copy of your complete WES Course-by-course or ICAS Postsecondary comprehensive assessment report.
- 3. Hold a bachelor's degree, a master's degree, or a doctorate in any domain, awarded by a Canadian or foreign institution plus two years of **full-time*** translation experience in the language combination for which you are applying.
 - A copy of your degree.
 - A copy of your **complete** WES "course-by-course" or ICAS specific evaluation (if degree is foreign).
 - A copy of your transcripts.
 - Letters of reference from at least one employer or two or more clients (if freelance) indicating full-time experience in the language combination for which you are applying.
- 4. Have the equivalent of four years of **full-time*** translation experience in the language combination for which you are applying.
 - Letters of reference from at least one employer or two or more clients (if freelance) indicating full-time experience in the language combination for which you are applying.

	IMPORTANT, MUST-READ INFORMATION
•	You will be contacted by email informing you whether your application is accepted or rejected. Applications will be rejected and destroyed as per our administrative procedure if they do not meet the requirements. To reapply, you must submit another application and pay the application fee again.
•	The contents of your application package must be written in either English or French. Documents written in any other language will need to be translated into either English or French by an ATIO-Certified Translator (https://atio.on.ca/directory/).
•	Non-required admission documents will not be consulted, conserved, or returned to applicants. These documents will be destroyed as per our administrative procedure.
•	Once approved, you are required to write an Entrance Exam within 12 months of the date of your acceptance letter.
