



Call for Nominations

Each form must bear the candidate's signature and the signatures of two (2) individuals in good standing of ATIO (at least one of whom is certified) who are nominating the candidate (s. 12.03).

Persons capable of holding more than one position on the Board are encouraged to stand for all these positions; once elected to one position, candidates may withdraw their name for the other position(s), unless they wish to hold more than one position (s. 13.03).

Candidates may submit a curriculum vitae and/or statement no longer than one (1) page, for distribution at the Annual General Meeting (s. 12.04).

The meeting will open at 12:00 p.m.

The meeting proper will be called to order at 1:00 p.m. The Returning Officer will accept nominations during the election for positions for which there are either no candidates, or only one candidate.
