THE ASSOCIATION OF TRANSLATORS AND INTERPRETERS OF ONTARIO

HONORARY MEMBER OF ATIO

Adopted by the Annual General Meeting on April 5, 2008

- 1. The Association confers the title of "Honorary Member of ATIO" to persons, whether or not they are certified members of the Association, who are recognized as deserving of being honoured by the Association or its professions. A sitting member of the Board of Directors may not receive the honour.
- 2. The title of honorary member does not confer professional status and is not linked to the certification conferred by the Association.
- 3. The title of honorary member can be granted at an annual general meeting of the Association, pursuant to a recommendation of the Board of Directors.
- 4. The title of honorary member can be withdrawn only be a decision of the Board of Directors.
- 5. The names of the honorary members of the Association, living or deceased, are recorded in the register of the Association, with an explanatory note as to why the title has been granted. The Association publishes the list in its directory and on its Web site.
- 6. Honorary members may attend annual general meetings but do not have the right to vote unless they are certified members of the Association.
- 7. Honorary members may not stand for election to the Board of Directors unless they are certified members of the Association.
- 8. Honorary members receive the same communications as other members of the Association but do not pay dues unless they are also certified members or candidates for certification.
